

What is the Wake County LICC?

It is a collaborative partnership among:

- parents,
- caregivers,
- public agencies (such as Children's Developmental Services Agency, Wake County Human Services & Wake County Public Schools),
- private and non-profit organizations,
- interested community members or organizations,

to promote a coordinated and effective Early Intervention System in Wake County.

What is Early Intervention?

Early Intervention is an array of services and supports available to families of young children (birth to five) who have a developmental delay/disability, atypical development, or are at risk for these.

What are these services?

- screening
- evaluation
- intervention
- family support
- therapies
- home-based & classroom-based services
- parent information/ referral to resources



The LICC needs INPUT from families!

The Early Intervention System is made up of many services. Families are encouraged to participate and answer important questions:



Is the system:

- working?
- available?
- timely?
- coordinated?

PARENTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR STIPENDS FOR PARTICIPATION IN LICC ACTIVITIES/MEETINGS.

Parents are encouraged to call/email whether or not they can attend meetings. You can:

- join the LICC and become an active member
- participate in specific goal areas that interest you
- receive information on support groups and area resources
