Items to be Covered by CSHS

Bathing Items not on the DMA fee schedule

- Grab bars
- *Aqua-tec & Fortuna Bath Systems
- Hand held shower
- *Slider Bath Track System
- Extension legs/bases for bath chairs
- *Bath Chairs not on the fee schedule (Ex: lg. Columbia)
- Pediatric **Walkers**: Kaye, Strider & Buggy
- Pediatric **Crutches**: Easy Walk etc.
- *Prosthetics (**No category needed. Use L codes**)
- ***Car Seats** & EZ on vests
- *No Code **wheelchair** items
 - Vent Trays
 - Versa Form for positioning
 - Molded backs/seats
 - Whitmyer Facial pads
- ***Thermo Regulation** Items (Ex: Coolees)
- *Benik products: **splints**
- Neck Collars**
- ***Positioning chair** when mobility system has no positioning components
- Reachers**
- Transfer Boards**
- Hospital Bed** Rail padding
- ***Toileting** Chairs and Items
- ***Cribs & Special Beds**
- Feeding** Items: dishes, spoons & feeding systems
- *Installed Home **Ramps**
- *Van **ramps** & tie down systems
- ***Standers**
- Orthotics** (Only requests that list Cascade or a therapy agency as the provider
Ex: Child & Family Development)

**Clinical review required*

Items NOT Covered by CSHS (Deny L3)

- *Gait Trainers
- Tables: any type
- Booster bases for pediatric strollers
- Wedges, Rolls
- Therapy Items
- Balls
- Benches
- Mats
- Thera Band
- Weights, Thera Putty
- Vestibular Equipment
- Positioning Chairs if the child has a mobility/positioning system
- Star Cars & Hand pedaled Trikes
- Tadpole type positioning systems
- *Clinical review required for Pacer (Rifton) and Gator (Snug Seat) which may be used as walkers*

Items to Purchase Directly Through Medicaid (Deny P3)

- Patient lifts (Ex: Hoyer)
- Rifton Bath Chairs (small, medium & large)
- Columbia Bath Chairs (small & medium)
- Columbia Wrap Around Bath Support
- Crutch tips
- Hospital Beds
- Orthotics (Not requests that list Cascade or a therapy agency as the provider)
- Helmets (NCBH is currently exempt)
- Side Lyers
